PUBLIC NOTICE

Subject: Regarding the publication of final election result statistics for various posts of the trust "The Asiatic Society of Mumbai" held on July 4, 2026, for the term 2025-27.

2. Order dated 13.03.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, in Misc. Application No. 32/2026.

With reference to the above subject, it is hereby informed that as per Reference No. 1, the then Election Officer of the trust had announced the election schedule for the selection of various vacant positions within the trust.

According to the said election schedule, all procedures except for the preparation of the final voters' list and the actual voting process were completed at that time by the then Returning Officer. In compliance with Point No. 7 of the order mentioned in Reference No. 2, the final voters' list was published on 10.06.2026. Furthermore, as per Point No. 8 of the same order; the actual voting process for the various vacant positions of the trust was conducted on 04.07.2026 between 10:00 AM and 04:00 PM. at Durbar Hall of the Asiatic Society of Mumbai. In the actual election process, out of a total of 2,545 voters, 517 voters exercised their right to vote.

Following the completion of the voting within the stipulated timeframe, the counting of votes commenced at 05:00 PM in the presence of the official candidates and their authorized representatives.


